BOARD MEMBER QUALIFICATIONS

Wisconsin imposes minimum qualifications for election to school board membership. Any eligible elector may be a candidate for school board membership. An eligible elector must be a citizen of the United States, 18 years of age, and a resident of the District for at least 10 days preceding the election. He/she must also reside in the area of apportionment which he/she is elected or appointed to represent, except as specifically authorized by law.

Residence for voting purposes is the place where the elector makes his/her permanent home and to which he/she expects to return if temporarily absent, or as otherwise defined by law. Board of Education members must file a written oath of office with the Board Clerk before they are legally entitled to hold office.
