**PRECEDENT SETTING SITUATIONS**

In the process of the administration of policies, administrative rules, and by-law situations, conditions which were not anticipated may arise which are precedent setting in nature.

At such times when such situations arise, the Superintendent of Schools shall pursue one of the following courses of action:

1. Immediate decision required
  - a) Make a judgment decision.
  - b) Report decision to the Board of Education at the next scheduled meeting of the Board.
  - c) Make recommendations to the Board of Education if revision or nullification of a policy, administration rule or by-law is deemed appropriate.
  
2. Immediate decision not required
  - a) Present the policy and ramifications of the situation to the Board of Education.
  - b) Make recommendations to the Board of Education if revision or nullification of a policy, administration rule or by-law is deemed to be appropriate.
