POLICY DEVELOPMENT

The Board of Education has two policy functions - policy making and policy evaluation. Statements of principle adopted by the Board serve as a guide to the decisions of the Board and District Administrator when problems that are similar in nature are considered.

Except as a part of any annual review of policies, all policies presented for consideration during the year shall be read at two scheduled Board meetings. New or revised policy proposals may then be adopted on a simple majority vote at the second reading. Policy deletion will require two readings.

Any Board member may move for a separate vote on any single policy when the Board is considering action on more than one policy at one time. If the motion is seconded and passed, a separate vote will be conducted on said policy.
