VOTING

Unless otherwise specifically provided by law, no secret ballot may be utilized to determine any election or decision except the election of Board of Education officers in any meeting. The motions and roll call votes of each meeting shall be recorded, preserved and open to public inspection to the extent prescribed by law.

If a vote is unanimous, it shall be recorded by number on a voice vote. If the vote is not unanimous, the Board Clerk shall list the names of the members who abstain, and those voting in the minority.

A roll call vote may be taken on all monetary issues or on any issues where the Board President or a Board member requests a roll call vote.
