HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

Homebound instruction is considered to be an alternative service to be provided only during specific periods of time when a student cannot attend school. It shall be provided within the limits as prescribed by state law and in accordance with established guidelines.

With the District Administrator's permission, homebound instruction will be arranged by each building Principal through the Special Education Director as the need arises.
