GRADE LEVEL ACCELERATION

A student in the Lancaster Community School District who demonstrates exemplary achievement in all subject areas may advance to a higher grade level, in accordance with established procedures. This may include advancing from one grade level to the next or skipping one grade level. Accelerated placement would rarely exceed two years from the student's age peers.

Students who are considered for grade level acceleration should have the potential to perform at a level two years or more beyond normal curriculum expectations at the elementary level or three or more years beyond at the middle and high school level in all subject areas.
