PROCEDURES FOR CURRICULUM COMPACTING

Procedures for implementing curriculum compacting options for students identified as part of the talent pool include:

- 1. Student is identified as being able to master a portion of the standard curriculum in advance of the rest of the class.
- 2. Mastery of regular curriculum is assessed through the use of pre-testing to determine student's understanding of concepts.
- 3. The building principal meets with classroom teachers to design appropriate curriculum compacting activities for the student. Options include the following:
 - a. Individual or small group compacted curriculum delivered by classroom teacher.
 - b. Compacted curriculum activities for unit, topic, or concept covered in the regular curriculum.
 - c. Compacted curriculum in a specific subject area mastered by student.
 - d. Option for student(s) to present results of compacted curriculum to the entire class.
 - e. Enrichment activities which support compacted curriculum plan.
- 4. A curriculum compacting plan is developed, including curriculum to be compacted, alternative learning strategies and materials, time lines for completion, and student products or outcomes.
- 5. Student works individually or in small groups to complete curriculum compacting plan. Contact with classroom teacher or gifted and talented coordinator is provided on an as needed basis.
- 6. Student presents final product or is tested to determine mastery of compacted material.
- 7. Student's efforts are evaluated and the need for further compacting or a return to the regular curriculum is determined.

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
