## COURSEWORK THROUGH INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING

## Youth Options Program

Any student who meets established requirements may enroll in courses at a technical college or institution of higher education under the youth options program with the approval of the school board. Admission of students shall be contingent on meeting the requirements outlined in state law. Application and notification procedures shall be established so that District and postsecondary planning and reporting may take place.

The high school principal, or his/her designee, shall determine whether the course(s) is comparable to a course offered in the District, whether the course satisfies District graduation requirements, and what, if any, high school credits are to be awarded to the student for the course. If such course(s) is taken for high school credit, the Board shall pay the costs in accordance with state law and regulations.

The high school principal, or his/her designee, shall provide information about the program to all 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students in accordance with established procedures.

After attaining senior status, a student shall be eligible for participation in the program for no more than two consecutive semesters. A student is determined to have senior status upon completion of a minimum of 18 credits.

Attendance at UW-Platteville (other than under Youth Options Program) In order to better prepare themselves for their chosen field in life, some students may wish to widen the scope of their education by taking a college course at the UW-Platteville.

A request to attend a class at UW-Platteville, other than through the youth options program, must receive final approval from the high school guidance counselor and the principal. Approval or rejection of such requests shall be in accordance with established criteria.
