GRADING SYSTEMS

Grading systems shall be designed to report to parents/guardian the progress of their children. The system used shall report the student's achievement.

A specific grading system shall be developed for various grade levels by each building principal and reviewed by the Ad-team before implementation.

Grades shall be issued on a regular basis to promote a process of continuous evaluation of student performances.

The Board recognizes that teachers are the best evaluators of their students and are best suited to determine grade criteria. District students may seek changes in quarter or semester grades, in accordance with established guidelines.

The District shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for evaluating students on the basis of gender, race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap.

This policy does not prohibit the use of special testing or counseling materials or techniques to meet the individual needs of students.

Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
