SCHOOL LEARNING/INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS CENTERS (LMCs)

Learning materials centers (LMCs) containing books, reference books and special instructional materials available to students and teachers are maintained in each of the District schools. New acquisitions may be made on the recommendations of teachers, principals or IMC director.

The LMC director, and staff under their direction, instructs students in all use of the IMC, supervise the distribution and use of all IMC materials, and assist classroom teachers in the use of special instructional materials. The IMC director assists the classroom teacher in selecting materials for unit work.

Students are authorized to use the school IMCs for research, individual study and review, and current reading.
