

STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE BENEFIT

The School District may provide a pupil accident benefit plan which affords coverage as limited by the insurance plan in the event of an accident at school. The charge for this benefit plan is paid by the School District.

The limit of this document does not allow a complete explanation of the terms of student insurance benefits but parents are urged to read the brochure completely when it is distributed in the fall. Questions in connection with the plan should be referred to the principal or athletic director at the High School or to the principals of the Middle School or Winskill Elementary. All accidents which occur at school should be reported immediately to these individuals. Forms provided by the School District Safety Director should also be filled out immediately following any school accident or injury (including athletics).
