The Board expects each instructional staff member to:

- maintain a current knowledge of the pedagogy and content of his/her major field of instruction;
- maintain a knowledge and appreciation of the characteristics, needs, and problems of children and adolescent youth;
- maintain an active interest and participation as a team player on respective faculty;
- make a positive contribution in the overall plan of the District;
- provide teaming experiences and opportunities for all children that will allow each child to develop his/her skills, understandings, and concepts to the maximum limits of his/her capacity, interests and needs;
- maintain a concern and interest in developing, using, and evaluating new materials and methods of instruction.
- maintain a positive approach to classroom instruction with each student being emphasized as a unique individual;
- maintain a high degree of professional behavior with the students, other staff members, administrators, and the community; and
- maintain a professional awareness of the certification and educational requirements expected in their disciplines by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction and to continue to meet those standards.
