TRANSPORTATION POLICY

The school district provides transportation for resident students, both public and private, living two or more miles from the school in attendance. Distance is measured from the school building to the residence of the student. Exceptions may be made to the two mile limit depending on safety conditions and available capacity on school buses. Requests for special consideration should be referred to the transportation supervisor or the administrator.

Transportation will be provided for all students living two or more miles from school. However, after buses have completed their regular route, and if there is still room, students living in outlying areas may qualify for transportation to school if the area is approved by transportation committee.
