**FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT**

The school lunch program is an integral part of the total education program, and as such shall be governed by the same principles and type of control as any other division of the school system.

The School District may provide lunches through participation in the National School Lunch Program. The School Board shall enter into an agreement with the Department of Public Instruction and the federal government for participation in such child nutrition programs.

As required for participation in the National School Lunch Program, the school district agrees to the following:

That a school lunch meeting federal regulation be made available for all students.

That free and reduced price lunches be offered to eligible students, who apply and who meet the federal income guideline.

The District Administrator is responsible for the management of the school lunch program, including the purchase of food and materials. The District Administrator may delegate specific duties in relation to the school food service programs to the Food Service Supervisor.

The School District may also participate in the Food Distribution Program, the Morning Milk Program, the School Breakfast Program, Elderly Lunch Program and the nutrition education and training program.

Food services programs shall be reviewed annually.

The School District shall not discriminate in school-sponsored food service programs on the basis of age, sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap.
