

STATE MEET ONLINE TICKETING - NEW THIS YEAR!!

The 2021 WIAA Cross Country State Championship features ONLINE TICKETING ONLY. Fans can purchase tickets by visiting the following link: https://gofan.co/app/events/396455?schoolId=WIAA2 Ticket prices (\$9 plus fees)...NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR ADMISSION TO THE MEET

You will be asked to present your digital ticket at The Ridges main entrance. You will not need to present your ticket to ride the shuttle to the meet.

Note: You will need a mobile device to enter the State Cross Country Meet. If members of your travel party do not have mobile device accessibility you may purchase additional tickets on your account for those individuals.

PARKING - NEW THIS YEAR!! (CASH ONLY)

Wisconsin Rapids Lincoln High School and the Grand Rapids Lions Club will be the only shuttle sites this year (\$5 parking fee per vehicle/\$25 parking fee for Fan Buses). There will be no charge to board the buses and shuttle to and from The Ridges. You will be asked to present your digital ticket at The Ridges main entrance. You will not need to present your ticket to ride the shuttle to the meet.
