CITIZEN(S) AND DELEGATIONS PRESENT AT THE MEETING REQUESTING AN ITEM BE CONSIDERED BY THE BOARD Every public notice of a meeting of a governmental body shall set forth the time, date, and place and subject matter of the meeting, including that intended for consideration at any contemplated closed session, in such form as is reasonably likely to apprise members of the public and the news media thereof. The public notice of a meeting of a governmental body may provide for a period of public comment, during which the body may receive information from members of the public.
- C. CITIZEN(S) AND DELEGATIONS PRESENT AT THE MEETING REQUESTING TO SPEAK ON SPECIFIC POSTED AGENDA ITEM. The first 30 minutes of each regular meeting and special meeting may be set aside for public participation, under the "Public Participation" portion of the agenda, if requested.
