Lancaster Community School District is located in the scenic rolling hills of southwestern Wisconsin in Lancaster, population approximately 4,000. We provide excellence in education in our three schools:

- **Winskill Elementary School**
(462 students pre-K through grade 5)
- **Lancaster Middle School**
(195 students in grades 6 through 8)
- **Lancaster High School**
(293 students in grades 9 through 12)

On our teaching staff are 88 certified teachers (a student-to-teacher ratio of 11 to 1) We also employ 47 paraeducators and support staff.

We pride ourselves on promoting high student achievement. We strive to exceed state requirements in reading, math, science, and social studies and provide many co-curricular opportunities for our students.

How We Do It

We emphasize academic excellence by continually upgrading and refining our curriculum. We offer training for our staff in their content areas as well as in innovative teaching strategies.

We offer our students Advanced Placement, advanced standing courses, and access to the Youth Options program. A districtwide special education program, K-12 guidance services, RTI, Title I support, and after-school homework clubs serve at-risk students. A summer enrichment program is enjoyed by students at all levels.

Our parents add spirit to the district's efforts by supporting and participating in music and sports booster clubs, a chemical abuse prevention program (C.A.S.H.—Chemical Abuse Stops Here), an FFA alumni group, and Friends of Winskill.
