BOARD ELECTIONS

Nine members constitute the Lancaster Board of Education. Three members are elected each year at the general spring election, for a period of three years, in accordance with the plan for apportionment. Elected school Board members take office on the fourth Monday in April.

If there are more than twice as many candidates as there are members to be elected to the Board, a primary election is mandatory. The primary election shall be held at the time specified by state law for the spring primary, the third Tuesday in February.

Declaration of Intent

Any qualified elector desiring election to the Board must file a declaration of intent with the Board Clerk, using forms provided by the District, no later than 5 P.M. on the first Tuesday in January. Qualified candidates shall then be placed on the ballot.

Incumbent Board members may file a notification of non-candidacy by 5:00 p.m. on the 2nd Friday preceding the deadline for filing ballot access documents to avoid an extension of time for filing such papers.

The order of names on the ballot shall be determined by lot, in the event more than one person seeks office from a representative area.
