ANNUAL SCHOOL DISTRICT PERFORMANCE REPORT

Annually the Lancaster Board of Education shall distribute a District performance report to the parent/guardian to each student enrolled in the District.

The following information by the District shall be provided in the report:

1. Indicators of academic achievement, including student performance on state tests as required by law;
2. Other indicators of school and District performance, including dropout, attendance, retention in grade and graduation rates; percentage of habitual truants; percentage of students participating in extracurricular and community activities and advanced placement courses; percentage of graduates enrolled in postsecondary educational programs; and percentage of graduates entering the workforce;
3. Suspension and expulsion information as required by law;
4. Staffing and financial data information as required by law;
5. A comparison of the District's performance under items 1 and 2 above with the performance of other school districts in the athletic conference.
