**PROCEDURES FOR ENRICHMENT**

Procedures for implementing enrichment options for students include:

1. The building principal shall:
  - a. supply classroom teachers with resources for providing appropriate enrichment activities for students in the talent pool;
  - b. assist classroom teachers in designing appropriate enrichment activities for students; and
  - c. act as a resource for the classroom teacher by assisting in the delivery of enrichment activities for students.
2. Enrichment activities may include:
  - a. Whole group enrichment activities delivered by classroom teacher or designee.
  - b. Small group enrichment activities facilitated by classroom teacher or designee.
  - c. Individual enrichment activities monitored by classroom teacher or designee.
  - d. Enrichment activities that involve community members.
  - e. Enrichment activities that involve a mentor.
  - f. Enrichment activities that involve older students acting as facilitators or coaches.
  - g. Enrichment activities facilitated by parents/guardians.
  - h. Enrichment activities provided by non-school activities inside and outside of the community.
3. Decisions regarding enrichment activities shall be based upon a consideration of a student's full range of abilities, interests, and needs (social, emotional, physical and mental maturity).
4. The student's task commitment, motivation, and ability to work independently shall be considered when designing and providing enrichment activities.
5. An ongoing evaluation of enrichment activities shall be conducted to ensure the student is receiving appropriate programming.
6. The building principal and classroom teacher shall maintain a record of all program modifications for participating students .
7. The building principal and classroom teacher shall act as a resource for parents/guardians to provide ideas and information on enrichment opportunities.
