Instruction

CLASS SIZE

Class size shall be considered the number of students under the jurisdiction of a regular teacher at any one time. Regular classes are those instructed by regular classroom teachers and do not include those instructed by remedial or counseling specialists or by itinerant teachers.

Average class size is determined by dividing the total enrollment in all regular classes by the number of regular classroom teachers. The classes of specialists are frequently much smaller, and sometimes larger, because of the nature of their work and are not to be considered in determining average class size.

Each principal shall report the enrollment of each class or section in his/her school to the District Administrator on the third Friday of each semester.

The principal shall also notify the District Administrator of any instances where class size is too large or too small for effective instruction and efficient use of personnel and may recommend a solution.
