**ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE HIGHER EDUCATION
SCHOLARSHIP TIE-BREAKING CRITERIA**

If a tie exists for the designation of academic scholar for purposes of the Wisconsin Academic Excellence Higher Education Scholarship, the high school faculty shall use the following criteria to break the tie to name the scholar(s) and prioritize the remaining students as alternates:

1. The senior with the highest grade point average, using the 11 point scale, shall be selected.
2. If there is a tie in #1 above, the student shall be selected from the students tied in #1 and who has the highest ACT composite score.
3. If there is a tie in #2 above, the student that has earned the most credits at the end of seven semesters shall be selected.
4. If there is a tie in #3 above, the student shall be chosen by lot.
