EMERGENCY CLOSING

When late starts or closing of schools must be considered because of hazardous or inclement weather, utility failure, civil disorder, or other safety impelling emergencies, the final decision will be made by the Administrator or his/her appointed representative after consulting with the Transportation Supervisor and/or other interested parties.

School delays, closing or early release will be reported to Radio Station W.T.O.Q., Platteville and Radio Station W.G.L.R/W.A.X.L., Lancaster by the Administrator. Bus drivers, teachers, parents, and students should listen to these radio stations and be guided by announcements that pertain to Lancaster Schools.

At the discretion of the Board of Education, days missed shall be made up by the teachers and/or students on dates specified by the School Board or its designated representative.
