Visitors

OPERATIONS: **HEALTHY ENVIRONMENTS**

Ventilation

New air ionization equipment was installed in each school to improve air-flow and quality

Cleaning and Disinfecting

All classrooms and restrooms will be disinfected throughout the school day

Communal Spaces

Middle/High School lunch rooms will be disinfected between uses

Hand Hygiene

Best practices will be taught and reinforced at all grade levels

OPERATIONS: PHYSICAL SPACES

Safety Signage

To promote safety, informational signage will be posted throughout school buildings:

1. Hand Hygiene
2. Social Distancing
3. Symptoms

Isolation Room

Isolation spaces are located in or near each school office

Hand Sanitation Stations

Increased placement and encouraged usage
Stations will be placed in each classroom, building entrances and exits, and lunch rooms

OPERATIONS: TRANSPORTATION

Self-Transport

Parents and/or students planning to self-transport are encouraged to contact their school's office to increase accuracy of routes and staffing requirements
With the help of our families who are able to transport their students, we can reduce our bus riders to enhance social distancing

Health and Safety

Buses will be disinfected following each route with special attention given to high-touch areas

DAILY SELF-CHECK FOR FAMILIES

Symptoms may appear 2 to 14 days after exposure to the virus. If your child has any of the following symptoms, please keep them home until symptoms are resolved:

- Fever (Temperature of 100.4 or greater), or chills or rigors
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
