Dear High School Students and Parents,

I hope you are as excited as I am to return to school. It seems like forever since students walked through the halls. There are some items I wish to discuss that will hopefully answer questions and also allow us the best opportunity for us to stay face to face. We will need everyone in full cooperation to be successful.

Let's begin our day.

- Students enter the high school through the main entrance. All students must use hand sanitizer as they enter the building. Doors open at 7:35 AM.
- Face coverings must be on and worn correctly, covering the mouth and nose at all times
- Staff will be available to help answer student questions in the main hallway.
- Students may go get breakfast. Students not eating breakfast will report directly to first hour class. Students grabbing breakfast should immediately report to first hour class to eat their breakfast.
- Teachers will explain the new expectations first hour and they will be reinforced throughout the day in all other classes.
- The hallways in the high school are one way. There are arrows indicating flow of traffic on the floor. There is also signage promoting social distancing and face coverings as well symptoms and what to do throughout the school. Please walk single file in the hallways and maintain social distancing.
- We will have a ZOOM ROOM for large class sizes. Students will rotate into the ZOOM ROOM based on student numbers. The ZOOM ROOM may be the study hall, commons or auditorium. Teachers will determine rotations. Please bring ear buds.
- We will have two lunch periods. Freshman and sophomores will eat first. Juniors and seniors will attend homeroom. The rotations switch for a 30 minute lunch for each group. There will be outside seating available for students wishing to eat in the fresh air. There will be five or less students per table with dividers for separation.
- Students will be using the hand sanitizer station upon entry and exiting each classroom.
- Please bring your own water bottles. Only bottle filling stations are available for use.
- Classrooms are encouraged to go outside. Be prepared for outside classes.

- Lockers are to be used either before school, at lunch or after school. Please bring backpacks with you to carry supplies throughout the day. Lockers should not be used at any other times. There is no need to decorate lockers at this time.
- The office door will be closed throughout the day. The window in front is available for drop off or pick up.
- Students leaving the building are expected to do so in a timely fashion, using hand sanitizer and maintaining social distancing. Please take chromebooks and materials home each day as educational means of delivery may change overnight based on Covid 19 information.
- Visitors are limited.

Please understand these expectations are in place for the health and safety of the students and staff. We all must do our part to make this work in the face to face setting.
