

## NCAA ELIGIBILITY CENTER

Students who aspire to compete in Division I or II athletics at the collegiate level must register with the NCAA Clearinghouse at the end of your junior year and meet eligibility requirements, including taking 16 credits from a list of credits approved by the NCAA. ## SELECTIVE SERVICE REGISTRATION

All men living in the US and US citizens living abroad are required by law to register with the Selective Service within 30 days of their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. Failure to register can close the door to college loans, grants, work study; access to job training programs, millions of federal jobs and state and municipal jobs. ## ACT TESTING

**ALL JUNIORS WILL TAKE THE ACT TEST ON MARCH 3, 2020.** The makeup date for this test is March 17<sup>th</sup>. Juniors will participate in ACT Test prep three times per week during WIN time. Juniors will rotate through Reading, Science, Math and English prep classes with content area teachers who are going through retired ACT tests with the goal of not only refreshing academic skills, but also understanding good test-taking skills specific to each content area. ACT scores are now used not only by four-year colleges, but also many two-year technical colleges who use the Reading and Math sub-scores to determine if students are academically prepared for their programs of choice. *It is important that all students give their best effort on this test.*

## ACT ASPIRE

ACT Aspire will be given to all freshmen and sophomores in April and/or May of 2020. The Aspire test is a version of the ACT and will predict future ACT scores. Please take these tests seriously as not only will the school look at the scores for educational planning purposes, *but the scores will also go on your transcript!*
