

## COLLEGE APPLICATIONS

Four-year colleges and universities and technical colleges are now processing applications. Seniors should be filling out applications. Most colleges prefer online applications. The Guidance Office will send out transcripts as requested. Please note that some programs at technical colleges fill up quickly, so early application is recommended.

## EARN COLLEGE CREDIT IN HIGH SCHOOL

A number of courses taken at Lancaster High School can earn college credits for students. Some earn advance standing for students at technical colleges while some earn actual technical college credits which transfer into the UW-System. Please see the Earn College Credit While in High School link in the left-hand column. Also, Advanced Placement classes allow students to earn college credit in AP subjects by scoring well on an exam at the end of the course.
